SICKNESS



If your child is sick with cold, flu, or tummy upset, please ensure they rest at home until completely well. Children who come back still heavily affected by their illness cannot concentrate and may infect other students.

A child who becomes unwell whilst at school will be given the best possible care. HOWEVER, if your child is unable to continue with the normal school routine after care and rest, you will be required to collect the child or have a friend or relative do so. The school is unable to nurse or supervise an unwell child for an extended period of time.

HEAD LICE



'NITS' is an ongoing problem in the community - a problem that is difficult to eradicate. Could you please check your child's hair and give the appropriate treatment if it is needed. It is a good idea to

repeat the process in another 8-10 days to ensure that no part of the cycle has been left in the hair.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS SCHOOL ABSENCE

We need a **reason** if your child is absent from school. If you do not inform the school BEFORE or ON the day of absence, we will send an SMS. If a response is not received, you will receive an email the following day. If there is still no response, you will receive a Pink Letter. Please attend to this ASAP as it is a government requirement for your child to attend school. You may send an SMS to 0450 726 498 or send an email to admin@eccs.wa.edu.au with your Child's Name, Year Level, Date of Absence and Reason for absence. You may also sign a Parent Note and submit to the Admin office. Or you may call 9342 7377.

LATE COMERS or EARLY DEPARTURES

If your child came in late (after 8:30am) or child is coming back from an appointment, you (or they themselves if they are able to) need to sign in via Passtab on the iPad available on both campuses. If you need to pick up your child for any reason, you (Parent or authorized adult) need to sign them out using Passtab. Note that we are not releasing your child if they do not have an authorized adult with them, even if they are in High School. High School students still need a parent/authorized adult to take them out of school premises.
