LATE COMERS or EARLY DEPARTURES



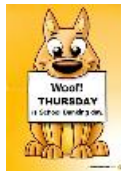

Note that we are not releasing your child if they do not have an authorized adult with them, even if they are already in High School. High School students still need a parent/authorized adult to take them out of school premises.
